Auctioneer: This year we welcome back for the ninth year, auctioneer and WICA board member Ellen Bergner Miller.

Consignments/Donations.

- Catalog descriptions including condition, were provided by the consignors and donors.
- WICA does NOT vet each item against its catalog description for damage or restoration.
- It is the responsibility of the bidder to review the items prior to bidding.
- WICA and its auctioneer assume no responsibility for catalog accuracy.
- The auctioneer will NOT identify damage during the auction.
- Items may NOT be returned once sold.

Auction Check-In will begin at 7 a.m. in the Ballroom of the Roses. Consignors are to come to the auction check-in at their pre-assigned time and should have the labels affixed to the items.

Auction Preview will begin at 4:30 p.m. in the Ballroom of the Roses.

Auction will begin at 8:00 p.m. in the Ballroom of the Roses.

Bidder Numbers have been included in your registration packets.

Consignment Fee Structure. WICA will retain 10% of the selling price. Items that do not have a reserve shall be sold to the highest bidder at the auction. Consignors will be paid within four weeks from the date of the auction.

Reserve Selling Price Option. Consignors can pay a non-refundable fee of \$10 for each item on which they would like to place a reserve selling price of \$100 or more. These items are to be sold to the highest bidder who submits a bid equal to or greater than the reserve.

Terms of Sale. ITEMS MAY NOT BE RETURNED ONCE SOLD. The bidder is responsible for reviewing the items prior to bidding and assuring the condition meets his/her requirements. Before bidding, please be sure that you CAREFULLY look over any items on which you intend to bid.

Time of Payment. All purchases must be paid for in full before leaving the premises on the day of the auction. Individuals who have consigned merchandise to the auction may NOT deduct purchases from proceeds from consigned lots.

Manner of Payment. Payment for purchases must be paid to the WICA cashier in the form of cash or personal check. Credit cards will NOT be accepted.

Dispute Between Bidders. If any dispute arises between two or more bidders, the auctioneer will decide how to handle the resale of the item. The decision of the auctioneer will be final and absolute.

Claims. No claims will be allowed before or after the goods are removed from the premises.

Personal and Property Risk. Persons attending during exhibition, sale or removal of goods, assume all risk of damage of or loss to person and property and specifically release the auctioneer and WICA from liability thereof.

Records of Sale kept by the auctioneer and WICA will be taken as final in the event of a dispute.

Additional Terms and Conditions shall be announced prior to the auction.
